



Campground Regulations

Woodbury County Fair Camping Regulations

1. The following rules and regulations will be adhered to by all campers. After a warning is given or being a habitual violator, you may not be allowed back in the campground area.
 - A. **\$175.00 for campers in full service sites which include: electric, water, and sewer from Sunday to Sunday.**
 - B. \$25.00 for campers in designated primitive area
 - C. \$6.00 for tent camping where no electricity or water hook-up is provided
 - D. \$5.00 for tent that is pitched with a paid camper – 1 tent limit per camper excluding screen porches
 - E. \$7.00 per day for any additional days prior to or at the conclusion of the fair. This includes Electrical and Primitive camping; Dates include Sunday before the fair until Sunday of the fair.
2. **ALL Campers must check in on Sunday, July 29th from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.**
3. A maximum of two vehicles per camping space will be allowed in the camping area. You **MUST** display your vehicle pass that will be affixed to the driver's side of your windshield by a Fair Board Representative. These vehicles shall not drive to and from livestock barns. Starting on Wednesday if vehicle permit is not affixed, no admittance will be allowed into the campground areas.
4. No pets are allowed on the fairgrounds, which includes the campground areas.
5. No golf carts are allowed in the camping area unless authorized by the Woodbury County Fair Board of Directors.
6. **Each person staying in the camper MUST have a season ticket or an exhibitor's ticket** upon checking into the campgrounds and **MUST** be listed on the registration form.
7. At least one adult listed on the registration form **MUST** be present in each camping unit if occupied overnight.
8. Persons not registered on the registration form will not be allowed to remain in the campground overnight.
9. All campers must back into their designated camp site. No pull through spots are available.
10. All livestock trailers will be left at the south end of the general public parking lot.
11. Visitors are asked to leave the campground area by 12 midnight.
12. Excessive noise will not be tolerated. Please be respectful of your neighbors in all ways, including language, children, etc. Quiet Time begins at 12 midnight.
13. Campers are asked to maintain the area assigned to them. Dumpsters will be provided.
