RULES

1. This project is open to any youth who has completed TK- 3rd Grade.
2. Classes will be divided as to the grades of youth involved in project.
3. The lamb may be any breed or any sex that is bucket or bottle – fed. No nursing is permitted and no bottle – feeding at fair. **LAMBS MUST BE SHEARED BEFORE FAIR!!!**
4. Record books must be turned in on entry day Tuesday of fair week. Exhibitor will not be allowed to show if their record books are not complete.
5. Lambs will be entered from 8:00-10:00 am and 4:00 -8:00 p.m. Tuesday of fair week. There will be NO early entries unless arrangements have been made with the superintendents.
6. Space is limited. No tack or boxes brought into barn until ok is given by superintendents. Additionally, superintendents reserve the right to ask exhibitors to move their fair boxes to the outside building to accommodate enough space for everyone.
7. Lambs will be shown with halter and should be broke to lead. Clipping and washing is necessary, brushing the lamb clean is the only preparation needed. Exhibitors will show by grades and will be judged on cleanliness of the lamb, showing and general handling of the animal and basic knowledge questions asked by a judge. Everyone will receive a ribbon and prize money that is donated.
8. Exhibitors are encouraged to wear proper show attire. Boots or hard toe shoes are suggested form of footwear. **JEANS ARE EXPECTED.**
9. Each exhibitor is responsible for the care of his or her lamb and keeping the pen clean at fair.
10. Lambs will be released on Sunday of fair week at the same time all other general livestock is released.
11. Lambs must be in good general health to be exhibited at the fair. Lambs must have scrapies tag or they will be sent home. Health rules from Woodbury County Fair Book will apply to this class. The fair veterinarian will have final say with regards to animal health and eligibility.
12. **NEW RULE FOR 3RD GRADERS IF YOU HAVE A EWE LAMB AND WOULD LIKE TO BRING IT BACK THE NEXT YEAR WHEN YOU JOIN 4-H. YOU NEED TO GET HER BRED AND HAVE A LAMB AND YOU CAN SHOW HER AS A PRODUCTION YEARLING EWE. WE WILL TAG HER AT FAIR.**
13. This year the shirts are not provided and can be bought for \$15.00. Adult shirts are also available for \$18.00. Please turn in money for shirts with your registration form.
